



CRA PROCESS FOR POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS

CRA Legislative Committee Membership. The Board of Directors shall appoint a Legislative Committee comprised of both CRA Board Members and current CRA members. CRA members will have the opportunity to nominate themselves or another CRA member to the committee. The Legislative Committee shall advise CRA staff on legislative and policy issues impacting the retail or business climate in California.

Objections by CRA Members. Any current CRA member may raise a concern with CRA staff regarding a recommendation of the Legislative Committee. CRA staff shall notify the Legislative Committee Chair regarding a recommendation where a CRA member raises an objection and provide an opportunity for the member to present reasons for their objection.

The committee will strive to seek a satisfactory, consensus recommendations to staff, but if consensus cannot be reached, the committee may approve a recommendation to staff by a majority of members. If there is not consensus among committee members, CRA members and staff shall be respectful of differing views within the organization

Each member of the committee shall have one vote.

Appeals of the Legislative Committee. Any current CRA member may appeal a policy recommendation to the Executive Committee or President of the Association.
